MHY USE A CHECKLIST?

Building your first home is exciting — but there are many steps. Use this checklist to stay organized and avoid missing key tasks:

- Budget & finance
- Choosing the right section
- Design + consents
- What to do during the build & at handover

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Define your budget (include land, build, landscaping, contingency) see our guide
 Building Costs A Future Homeowners Guide.
- Arrange finance or pre-approval with your bank/lender.
- o Research locations, sections, and zoning rules.
- Clarify goals: size, style, must-haves vs nice-to-haves.

CHOOSING YOUR SECTION

- Check sun, slope, access, and views.
- o Review covenants, zoning, and council overlays.
- o Get legal advice before you buy.
- o Consider geotech or soil reports.

PLANNING & DESIGN

- o Choose an architect/designer and a builder
 - o Ask for references and view recent projects
 - Check LBP licence status and insurance.
 - o Request upfront how the fee structure for professional services will work.
 - Compare any quotes: inclusions, exclusions, PC sums, timelines. <u>see our guide What</u>
 <u>Makes Up Your Build Contract Price</u>
 - Prepare concept plans and review against budget. Confirm materials, fixtures, and finishes early.
 - o Plan for energy efficiency and orientation where possible.

CONSENTS & APPROVALS – YOU CAN COMPLETE OR YOUR ARCHITECT/BUILDER CAN

- Apply for building consent (and resource consent if required)
- o Gather geotech, structural and stormwater reports.
- o Factor in consent fees and compliance costs.
- o Allow time for council processing and RFIs.

DURING THE BUILD

- Confirm start date and milestone timeline.
- o Have regular check-ins with your project manager.
- Track invoices, payments and variations.
- Lock decisions early (tiles, fittings, colours) to avoid delays.

AT HANDOVER

- o Complete final inspection and snag list.
- Obtain Code Compliance Certificate (CCC).
- o Receive warranties, manuals and as-built info.
- o Confirm maintenance schedule with your builder, if you've chosen to include this.
